### Classification Rate Schedules

EXAMPLE OF BUSINESS LICENSE FEE CALCULATION:

Class 3 Business with a gross income of \$2,500,000:

First \$2,000 @ \$40.00 .....= \$ 40.00

\$2,000 to \$1,000,000 @ \$1.15 per thousand (998 X \$1.15)= 1,147.70

\$1,000,000 to \$2,000,000 @ 95% of \$1.15 (1,000 X \$1.09)= 1,090.00

\$2,000,000 to \$3,000,000 @ 90% of \$1.15 (500 X \$1.04)= 520.00

TOTAL ..... =\$2,797.70

The total business license fee for the full amount of the contract shall be paid prior to commencement of work and shall entitle contractor to complete the job without regard to the time taken to complete the work.

No contractor shall be issued a business license until all State and City qualifications, examinations, and trade license requirements have been met. Each contractor shall post a sign in plain view on each job identifying the prime contractor with the job and shall furnish the Collection Officer with a list of all sub-contractors furnishing labor or materials for each project.

Sub-contractors shall be licensed based upon the gross amount paid to the sub-contractor for the work to be performed. No general or prime contractor shall be entitled to a deduction from gross income for the value of work performed by a sub-contractor.

No contractor shall be issued a business license until all performance and indemnity bonds required by the City Building Code have been obtained and approved.

Estimated additional revenue of each \$10,000 or portion thereof up to \$1,000,000 or each additional five exhibitors or portion thereof, whichever is greater. \$ 30.00
