CALL TO ORDER The Chairman, Joe Prothro, called the meeting to order at 11:59 p.m.

APPROVAL OF A motion to approve the October 21, 2009, and November 9, 2009 BAR Public Hearing and Meeting minutes was made by Willie Lee, seconded by Anne Norton. The minutes were unanimously approved.
