CALL TO ORDER Mayor D. Welborn Adams called the special called meeting in Council Chambers to order at 5:29 p.m.

STATEMENT AND QUORUM Mayor D. CONSIDER Under the only New Business, City Manager Charles Barrineau discussed Wesley Commons' request for City Police services to patrol their three parcels that was removed from the City over a year ago. In exchange for the City providing services, they will pay \$2,000 per year.

To Authorize the City Manager to Sign Extra-jurisdictional Contract for Police Services with Wesley Commons.

**DISCUSSION:**

City Manager Barrineau confirmed to Councilor Kenn Wiltshire that the City has a mutual aid agreement with the Ninety Six Highway 34 Volunteer Fire Department for Wesley Commons fire protection services.

There was no further discussion from Council.

A motion to authorize the City Manager to sign an extra-jurisdictional contract for police services with Wesley Commons was made by Betty Boles, seconded by Matthew Miller.

Those who voted in favor were Mayor Adams, Betty Boles, Matthew Miller, and Ronnie Ables. Kenn Wiltshire voted against.

The motion passed 4-1.
