



Storm Debris Cleanup Guidelines

Greenwood City Code Sec. 34-13. - Placing of yard waste for collection.

- a. All persons utilizing city collection of yard waste shall be required to place it in containers provided by the city or deposit it loosely at the curb for pickup by the city crews.
- b. Yard waste that will not fit in containers or roll-out carts will be placed on the depositor's property adjacent to the street, but *not in the street, gutter, ditch, sidewalk, nor on properties other than the premises of the depositor.*
- c. All yard waste, trash, refuse or debris resulting from building, repairing, remodeling, or any kind of construction shall be moved by the contractor, property owner or person having work done. The city shall not move trash, refuse, or debris of this nature. All trees, limbs, stumps, bushes, trash, debris, dirt and other refuse resulting from cleaning up or improving property shall be removed by the contractor, landscaping contractor, lawn care service, tree surgery company, property owner or person having the work done.
- d. No person shall be allowed to place adjacent to the street for collection limbs, or cuttings, greater than six feet in length, nor more than six inches in diameter and having a volume of no more than ten cubic yards without the prior consent of the city manager or his designee.
