“Mr. Mayor and Council, at your November meeting you took first reading on a budget. One element of that budget was to increase the commercial sanitation collection fees from \$.75 per cubic yard to \$.85. Those fees are controlled by a separate ordinance from the budget, so if we are to follow through with the second reading at the regular December meeting, we would need to take first reading on this tonight. If the second reading passes in the December meeting, then it will become effective January 1st, if that is Council’s wishes.”
